



Quick Overview for Educators

Implementing the *In One Instant* Teen Safe Driving Video Program at your school is *simple and easy*. Educators will understand how to host the *In One Instant* in the classroom or online by following these steps:

Step 1: Get Your School On Board

Sign up for the *In One Instant* Teen Safe Driving Program. It's **FREE** for a limited time only.

Step 2: Check Your Email For Your In One Instant Program Package

Upon signing up for the program, *In One Instant* will email you the Program Package, which includes a private link to the Video, Educators Guide to hosting post-program activities, and a link to the *In One Instant* Pre- and Post-Program anonymous Surveys for students.
